RETURN TO SCHOOL 8th MARCH 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the government announcement, we are very excited to have all children back at school on Monday 8th March 2021.

I outline the arrangements for the return to school below:

Drop off Timings and Arrangements

Drop off:

The gates open at **8:40am** and close at **8:55am**.

Reception enter through the pedestrian gate.

Years 1, 2 and 3 enter through the KS1 playground.

Years 4, 5 and 6 enter through the staff car park gate.

Nursery: AM drop off is 8.30am – 8.45am and Nursery PM drop off is 12.25pm – 12.35pm.

Please ensure that children are ready with all their bags and equipment before they enter the school site. We will not be able to facilitate forgotten bags or lunchboxes on the gate once the child has entered in line with our risk assessment.

Uniform

Children will be expected back to school in their full school uniform. Aqua uniforms are accepting online orders if you require new uniform for your children. Children will also be doing many outdoor activities and PE sessions. Please send your child's PE kit in on a Monday. They will require their PE kit to be in school all week and these will then be taken home every Friday or the last day of term. If you have any concerns please email: info@langleyheritageprimary.org

Lunches and book bags

Children will now be able to bring with them their pack lunches and a water bottle for daily use and these can be taken home by the children each day. However, if they are forgotten in the classroom at collection the child can take them home the following day.

Please note, Reception children may now also bring a packed lunch if they wish to.

We will be sending books and reading records home again for all year groups. Our normal expectations for reading will continue and children will be expected to read every night at home and this will be monitored in class.

Curriculum

We will ensure children's return to class is well balanced in terms of learning and wellbeing and that they are supported at every given stage. The curriculum will be tailored to support this for this term and to continue to build from the fantastic work that has been done by the children during this latest period of national lockdown. We will return to more normal provision for our children and ensure that they experience our exciting and engaging curriculum where possible.

Covid-19 Precautions

Children will be asked to wash hands and use hand sanitiser and we will continue to follow measures as set out in our risk assessment available on the website.

Please do not send your child to school if they or anyone in your household has a new and continuous cough, fever or a loss or change in sense of taste or smell or if you have been notified to self-isolate via the NHS test and trace. If your child is unwell or needs to self-isolate, there will be work available on Teams for them to complete and this will be updated weekly so that they can follow along with their peers in school. There will be no live lessons unless a year group needs to close.

As stated within the Government guidance school attendance is now mandatory. We will follow our normal attendance procedures to help support and monitor.
